

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Ob/Gyn Associates of Southern Indiana is committed to keeping everyone safe and healthy, especially our pregnant patients. With the current outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and with it still being flu season, we want to emphasize our policy to not bring patients with symptoms of upper respiratory infections (fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc) into our office.

We do not test for the Coronavirus or flu and request that patients with upper respiratory symptoms seek care from their primary care physician or an urgent care center.

If you are sick and have a scheduled appointment, we will ask you to reschedule. If you are in doubt or if you meet the CDC guidelines of a person at risk for Coronavirus due to symptoms and/or recent travel to a high-risk area with ongoing spread of COVID-19, please call the office for further instructions (812-945-5233).

We ask that patients limit the number of people that they bring with them to appointments and not to bring any visitors that are sick. Sick visitors will be asked to wait in the car or we may need to reschedule.

Baptist Hospital-Floyd has also activated infection control protocols until further notice to protect patients, as well as the staff and community. Mother-Baby and Labor and Delivery units will only allow parents, grandparents and siblings without a fever, cough or runny nose to visit. They also ask that the number of visitors be limited to two at a time.
